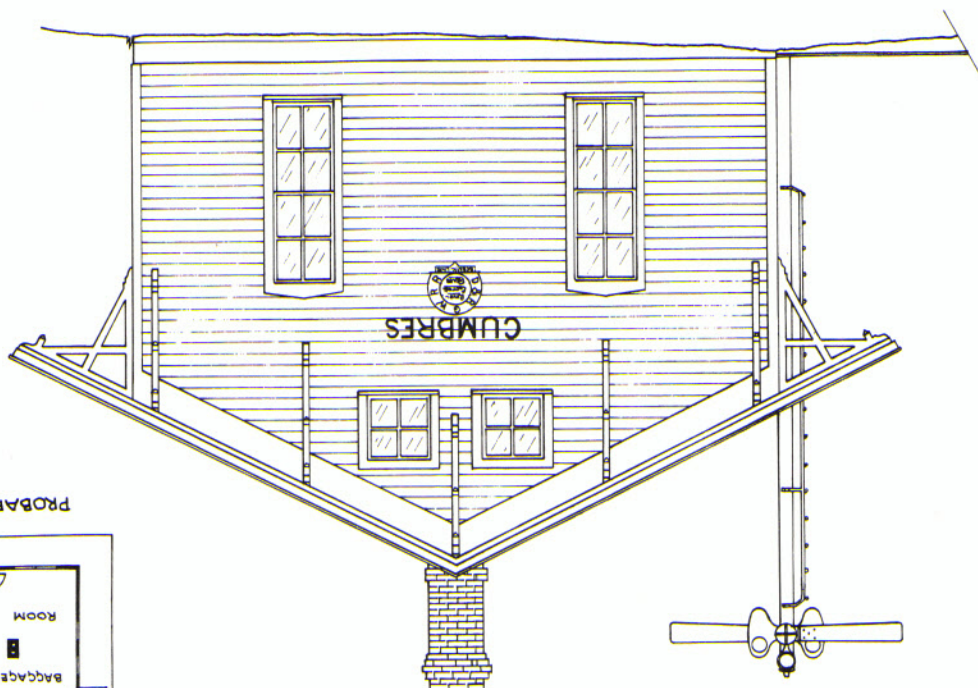
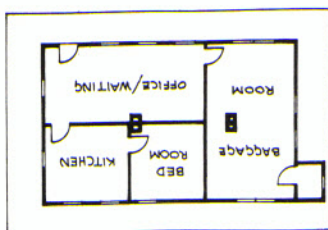


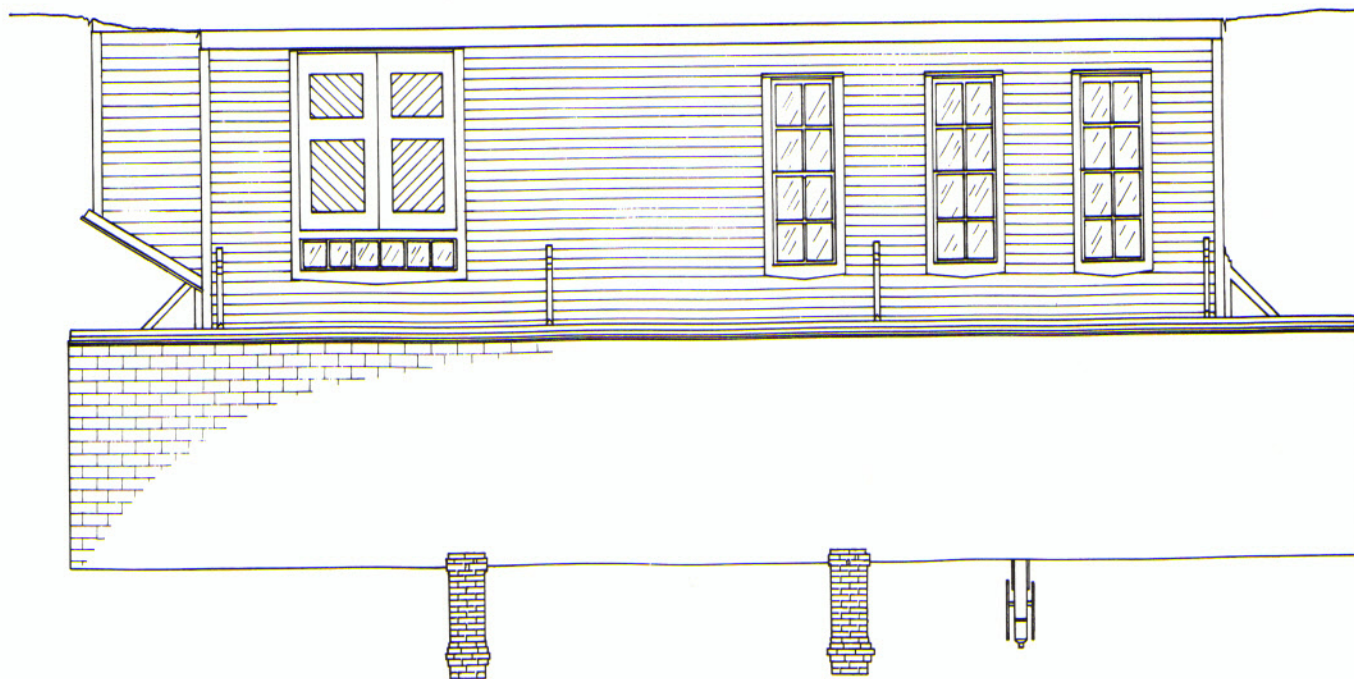

THE CUMBRES STATION WAS BUILT ABOUT THE TIME THE ORIGINAL ALAMOSA-DURANGO LINE WAS COMPLETED THROUGH TO CHAMA IN 1881. IT LASTED UNTIL 1954 VIRTUALLY UNCHANGED FROM ITS ORIGINAL FACADE. TRAVELLERS WELCOMED THE STOP AFTER EITHER THE CLIMB FROM CHAMA OR THE LOS PINOS VALLEY. BETWEEN TRAINS IT WAS A BEAUTIFUL LONELY SPOT WHICH MARKED MAN'S CONQUEST OF THE MOUNTAINS.
